Conduct Expectations:

Acceptable Behaviours:

- Show respect for ourselves, others (including adults) and for all property
- Be honest
- Come to school on time and prepared to learn
- Put forward our best effort
- Accepting responsibility for our actions and trying to fix our mistakes
- Behave in a way that is not disruptive to the learning of others or teacher activities
- · Being inclusive of all students and their individual differences and discrimination free at all times
- Non-discrimination and mutual respect for individual differences (Including but not limited to: age, race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, religion, family status, physical or mental disability, sex, sexual orientation or gender identity) as defined by the BC Human Rights Code
- Honouring School District 53 Student Conduct & Discipline Policy (F-3)

Unacceptable Conduct:

Behaviours that:

- interfere with the learning of others
- interfere with an orderly environment
- create unsafe conditions

Acts of:

- bullying, cyber bullying, harassment, or intimidation
- physical violence
- retribution against a person who has reported incidents

Illegal Acts, such as:

- possession, use, or distribution of illegal or restricted substances
- possession or use of weapons
- theft or damage to property

Consequences for students who violate the code of conduct:

- Responses to unacceptable conduct are consistent and fair
- Disciplinary action relates to the infraction and is preventative and restorative in nature, in line with School District 53 Student Conduct & Discipline Policy (F-3)
- Notification may occur from a variety of school officials depending on the severity of the action and where the school is at within the progressive discipline model
