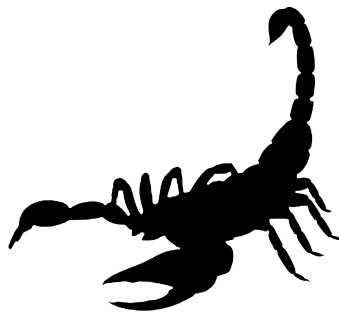

Oliver Elementary School is excited to host the District Track & Field Meet on Friday, June 5, welcoming student athletes from across the district. The event will run from 10:00 a.m. to approximately 1:40 p.m. and will feature Grade 4–7 students competing in a variety of events, including dashes, the 200m race, relay races, high jump, long jump, ball throw, shot put (Grade 7 only), and the 800m run. Families are encouraged to come cheer on our athletes as they demonstrate their hard work, sportsmanship, and school spirit.

To help make the day enjoyable for everyone, our PAC will be operating a concession from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., offering hot dogs, snacks, and drinks. 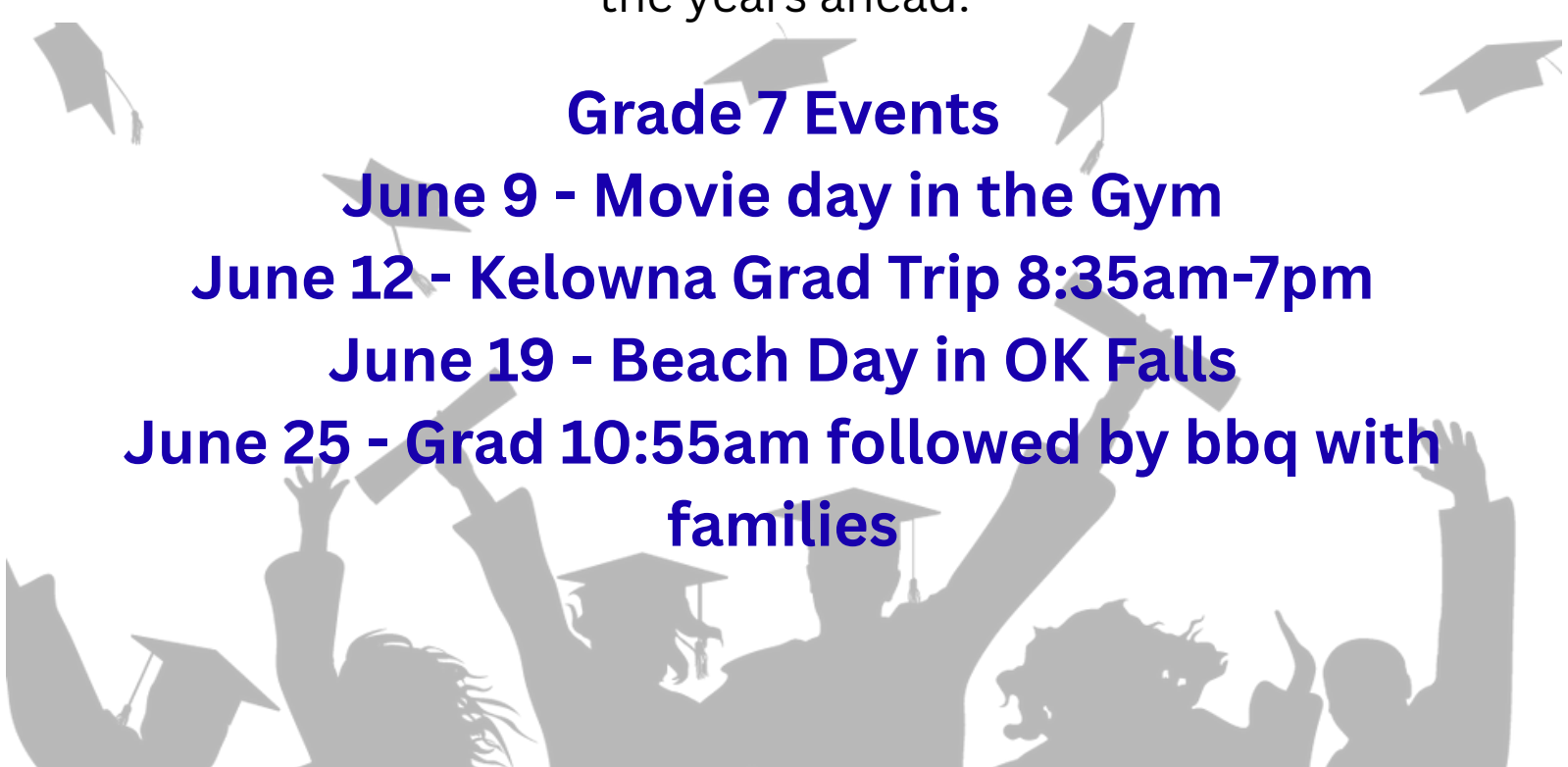
